

ORDINANCE NO. 1118

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF SIDEWALKS AND CURBS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 150.

The City of Hood River does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Definitions.

(1) As used in this ordinance except where the context otherwise indicates, the following terms mean:

- (a) City. The city of Hood River
- (b) Council. The city council.
- (c) Engineer. The city engineer.
- (d) Person. Every natural person, firm, partnership, association or corporation.

Section 2. Specifications.

(1) The council, by resolution or otherwise, shall adopt standard city specifications for sidewalk and curb construction, reconstruction and repair and such specifications shall be filed in the office of the engineer and recorder.

(2) All sidewalks and curbs shall be constructed, reconstructed or repaired in accordance with the standard city specifications.

(3) The council shall establish grades upon recommendation of city engineer and all improvements made shall conform to the established grades.

Section 3. Permits.

(1) No person shall construct, reconstruct, or repair any sidewalk or curb in or upon any public street or right-of-way without first obtaining a permit from the engineer.

(2) An application for a permit shall be filed with the engineer on a form provided by the city, together with such other information and data as may be required by the engineer.

(3) An applicant for a permit shall pay a permit fee to the city. The amount of the permit fee shall be calculated in the same manner as

a building permit fee is calculated under the schedule of fees provided in the building code, as amended.

(4) After determining that the improvement is to be constructed in accordance with standard city specifications and after the permit fee is paid to the city, the engineer shall issue a permit for the work.

Section 4. Supervision. The engineer shall make such inspections as in his judgment may be required to determine that the construction of any improvement for which a permit has been issued in proceeding in accordance with the standard city specifications.

Section 5. Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not to exceed 30 days, or by both.

Section 6. Repeal. Ordinance No. 150, enacted July 10, 1908, relating to sidewalk and curb construction is repealed.
