ORDINANCE NO. 1205

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 847 OF
THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER AS AMENDED AND IN
PARTICULAR THAT PORTION OF SAID ORDINANCE
PROVIDING FOR THE CLEARANCE OF TREES AND
THEIR LIMBS ABOVE STREET, CURB AND SIDEWALK

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 847 was enacted by the
City of Hood River on July 12, 1939, and now the Common Council
of the City of Hood River desires to amend and change that
ordinance to provide for more clearance from limbs and branches
thereof in the streets, and above the sidewalk, curb, and street.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 2 of said Ordinance No. 847
be deleted in its entirety and there be inserted in lieu thereof
and the same be amended to read:

Section 2: All shade and ornamental trees
which are now planted or growing in a natural state
or which may be hereafter planted or set out in the
streets or roads or alleys of the City of Hood River,
and those whose limbs shall reach over the streets,
roads or alleys of the City of Hood River shall be
trimmed each year and kept and maintained to a
height of not less than nine feet above the side-
walk and to a height of not less than twelve feet
above the street, curb, and alley, or any one of
them. The sidewalks, alleys and streets to the
City line are to be kept clean at all times from
leaves falling from such shade or ornamental trees.

Section 2: That the remainder and all other parts
of said Ordinance No. 847 shall remain in full force and effect.
