

ORDINANCE NO. 1289

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 839
TO PROVIDE THAT RIOTOUS OR DISORDERLY
MANNER AT A PUBLIC MEETING SHALL CONSTITUTE
A PUBLIC NUISANCE AND AN OFFENSE AGAINST
THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER, AND SETTING FORTH
THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That there is hereby adopted and made
a part of Ordinance No. 839 of the City of Hood River passed
by the Council May 15, 1939, and approved by the Mayor
May 17, 1939, a subsection (p) of Section 3 (5-2.3) to read
as follows:

"(p) To behave in a riotous or disorderly
manner in or at any public meeting of the council
of the city or of any division, agency, authority
or court thereof or at any public meeting of any
federal or state public body or any division,
agency or authority thereof, or to cause any
unnecessary disturbance therein by force or by
shouting or by any action calculated to disrupt
such meeting, or to refuse to obey any ruling
of the presiding officer of such meeting relative
to the orderly process thereof."

Section 2: That the penalties for a person found
guilty of causing or continuing a public nuisance by the
violation of the provisions set forth in Section 1 of this
ordinance shall be as provided in Section 4 of Ordinance
No. 839 shall apply to any violation of the provision of
the above newly adopted subsection (p) of Section 3 to the
original ordinance the same as though said above amendment
had been a part of the original ordinance.
