ORDINANCE NO. 1334

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PRESENT AND FUTURE DESIGNATION OF ALL THOROUGHFARES.

WHEREAS it has been determined that there should be some pattern in the designation of thoroughfares in the City of Hood River, both now and for the future, therefore,

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: That all public thoroughfares within the City of Hood River shall hereafter be designated in the following manner:

- a. Those running East and West shall be designated as avenues.
- b. Those running North and South shall be designated as streets.
- c. An irregular thoroughfare more than two blocks long but not conforming to an avenue or street grade pattern shall be designated as a drive.
- d. A North-South thoroughfare parallel to but between streets shall be designated as a place.
- e. An East-West thoroughfare parallel but between avenues shall be designated as a way.
- f. A thoroughfare entering in a cul-de-sac which cannot be extended shall be designated as a court.
- g. A small loop-type thoroughfare in and out of a neighborhood shall be designated as a loop.
- h. A private thoroughfare in and out of a private subdivision shall be designated as a lane.
- i. A thoroughfare in and out of a public park shall be designated as a parkway.
- Section 2: No thoroughfare within the City shall be designated as a road.
 - Section 3: All new thoroughfares shall be named

by action of the City Council and such name shall have not more than seven letters and not use personal names save and except if the same are of state or national prominence.
