

ORDINANCE NO. 1360

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 915,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1104, TO COMPLY
WITH STATE STATUTES AS TO THE COMPOSITION
OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS Chapter 739 of the Oregon Laws of 1973 (now
ORS 227.030 to 227.095) provided for a change in the number of
members of a city planning commission and provided that appointments
should be made by the city council and set a quorum and the council
wishes to bring its ordinance establishing the City Planning
Commission in line with state statutes, therefore,

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 915 adopted May 16, 1949,
as amended by Ordinance No. 1104 adopted June 4, 1960, as to
Sections 2 and 5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2: The City Planning Commission shall
consist of seven (7) members to be appointed by the
Council. Present members shall continue in office
for the period to which they have been appointed. Their
successors shall hold office for a period of four years.
Any vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired portion
of the term by the council."

"Section 5: A majority of the City Planning
Commission shall constitute a quorum."

Section 2: In all other respects, Ordinance No. 915, as
amended by Ordinance No. 1104 adopted June 4, 1960, be and the same
is hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 3: Whereas there exists an immediate necessity to
eliminate any conflict between city ordinance and state statute,
an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall
be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the

Council and approval by the Mayor.
