ORDINANCE NO. 1452

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A GENERAL PENALTY
FOR VIOLATION OF ORDINANCES, DECLARING
THE SAME TO BE A MISDEMEANOR, AND PROVIDING
LIMITATION.

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of any ordinance of the City of Hood River is guilty of a misdemeanor, except where the same would be deemed a "violation" under state law. Except in cases where a different punishment is prescribed by any ordinance of the City of Hood River, any person convicted of a misdemeanor under the ordinances of Hood River shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$750.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2: Each such person is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision of the ordinances of Hood River is committed, continued, or permitted by any such person, and he or she is punishable accordingly.

Section 3: The maximum penalty for a violation of any ordinance shall not exceed the maximum penalty prescribed for violation of a substantially similar offense as prescribed by the Oregon Criminal Code.
