

ORDINANCE NO. 1473

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1267  
AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO INCREASING SEWER  
SERVICE CHARGES.

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 1267 adopted October 22, 1969; as amended by Ordinance No. 1323 adopted December 11, 1972, as amended by Ordinance No. 1377, adopted October 28, 1975, as amended by Ordinance No. 1426 adopted May 23, 1978, is amended by deleting Section 3 of said ordinance as amended and placing in lieu thereof the following:

"Section 3: The rates and charges to be paid by each such person, firm or corporation for the sewer use services specified in Section 2 shall be computed on a per unit basis and the units are determined by the following chart:

Single-family dwelling	1 unit
Mobile home, outside of court	1 unit
Multipe-family dwelling	1 unit per family unit
High school	1 unit per 15 students
Elementary School	1 unit per 20 students
Motor courts	1 unit per 2 bathrooms
Trailer courts	1 unit per trailer space
Restaurant	1 unit per 6-seat capacity
Drive-in restaurant	1 unit per 6-seat capacity inside building
Clubs serving meals on a regular basis	1 unit per 18-seat capacity
Taverns, sandwich shops and pizza parlors with prepared food	1 unit per 18-seat capacity
Hospital and other institutions	1 unit per 3 beds
Each commercial and/or industrial occupant	1 unit per 9 or less employees
Launderettes	1 unit per 2 washers
Auto service stations	1 unit per 4 gas pumps
Theatre and other public meeting places	1 unit per 200-seat capacity
Churches (facilities for worship only)	1 unit per 200-seat capacity
Commercial disposer	1 unit each plus regular unit charge for building
Vegetable preparation room	1 unit each plus regular unit charge per building
Trailer dumping facility	1 unit each plus regular unit charge for other facilities at that location

Industrial establishments. Industrial waste load is to be paid for at the basic rate plus a minimum charge as determined by the following tables, and each to be negotiated as an understood contract with each industrial user:

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| (1) Having less than 150 p.p.m. (parts per million) of suspended solids and less than 200 p.p.m. of B.O.D. | One unit per 10,000 gallons of water used   |
| (2) Having more than 150 p.p.m. of suspended solids and less than 200 p.p.m. of B.O.D.                     | A base rate of 1 unit per 10,000 gallons plus 1 unit for each 100 p.p.m. of suspended solids over 150 p.p.m.      |
| (3) Having more than 200 p.p.m. of B.O.D.  | A base rate of 1 unit per 10,000 gallons of sewage flow plus 1 unit for each 300 p.p.m. of B.O.D. over 200 p.p.m. |

And the sewer use charges therefore shall be:

- (a) Within the corporate limits of the City of Hood River:
  - (1) for each unit shall be \$7.00 per unit up to and including the 10th unit.
  - (2) in excess of 10 units, the charge shall reduce at the rate of 10 cents for each additional unit, but in no event less than \$6.00 per unit.
- (b) Outside the corporate limits of the City of Hood River:
  - (1) for each unit shall be \$10.50 per unit up to and including the 10th unit.
  - (2) in excess of 10 units, reduce at the rate of 10 cents for each additional unit, but in no event less than \$9.50 per unit.
- (c) That all users served by pumping stations operated by the City of Hood River within or without the boundaries of the City of Hood River shall pay a surcharge, in addition to the charges above, of twenty-five (25%) percent. of their billings.

Section 2: All billings after the effective date of this ordinance shall reflect the increase in rates herein established.

Section 3: In all other respects Ordinance No. 1267

and its amendments prior to this date shall remain in full force and effect.
