

ORDINANCE NO. 1580
(AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 228 OF THE HOOD RIVER
MUNICIPAL CODE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE
CHIEF OF POLICE BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR WITH THE
CONSENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY)

The City of Hood River ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section Amended. Section 2.28.010 of the Hood River Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"Composition of Department and Appointment of Chief of Police. The police department shall consist of a chief of police and such other officers as the council may direct. The chief of police shall be appointed and dismissed by the city administrator subject to the consent of a majority of all members of the council.

With the imminent retirement of the current chief of police on December 31, 1986, and the need to maintain the peace, health and safety of the city, the city council hereby determines an emergency exists and orders this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon and after its passage by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of all the members of the City Council and the Mayor.
