

ORDINANCE NO. 1592

(AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.36 OF THE HOOD RIVER MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR WAIVER OF CERTAIN EXISTING RESTRICTIONS IN THE EVENT OF A SNOW CONDITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.)

Section 1. Hood River Municipal Code Section 10.36.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Parking methods and restrictions. A. No person shall stand or park a vehicle in a street other than parallel with the edge of the roadway, headed in the direction of lawful traffic movement and with the curbside wheels of the vehicle within twelve inches of the edge of the curb, except where the street is marked or signed for angle parking and except as provided in paragraph E. of this section.

Section 2. There is hereby added to the Hood River Municipal Code Section 10.36.010 E. which shall read as follows:

E. In the event of a snow condition as defined in Hood River Municipal Code Section 10.68.020 (c), parking of vehicles headed in the direction opposite to the direction of lawful traffic movement shall be permitted in the R-1, R-2 and R-3 Zones as designated in Hood River Municipal Code Chapter 17.03.

WHEREAS, the City of Hood River is experiencing a snow condition and finds it necessary to amend parking regulations in residential zones to accommodate reasonable practices during snow conditions, therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
