

ORDINANCE NO. 1653

The City of Hood River ordains as follows:

Section 17.01.060 of the Zoning Ordinance shall be amended to include the following:

Definitions: Public Park: An open or enclosed tract of land set apart and devoted for the purposes of recreation, ornament, light, and air for the general public. Allowed uses are:

1. Recreational activities.
2. Playgrounds.
3. Non-profit community activities.
4. Temporary concessions incidental to and serving park/recreation users.
5. Swimming pools.
6. Tennis courts.
7. Arts festivals.

Except as amended herein, Section 17.01.060 of the Zoning Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
