

ORDINANCE NO. 1677

(An ordinance amending Sections 17.13.030 D. and 17.13.150 B. of the Zoning Ordinance relating to sign regulations)

The City of Hood River ordains as follows:

Sections 17.13.030 D. and 17.13.150 B. of the Hood River Municipal Code are hereby amended to read as follows:


- a. 17.13.030 D. BUILDING FACE: Building face is all the window and wall area of a building on one (1) plane.
- b. 17.13.150 B. All nonconforming signs for a single entity shall be made to comply with this ordinance when structural alteration, relocation, replacement with a different sign or application for a new sign for that entity occur. Repair of a part of a sign or sign structure to a safe condition, including normal maintenance, shall be permitted without loss of its nonconforming status, provided that there are no other changes to the sign or sign structure. However, a change of copy indicating a change of ownership shall require compliance with this ordinance.

Except as amended herein, Chapter 17.13 of the Zoning Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
