ORDINANCE NO. 1777

(An ordinance amending Chapter 5.12 of the Hood River Municipal Code
- Peddlers and Solicitors)

WHEREAS, the City has received complaints of door-to-door soliciting during hours it deems to be unreasonable;

WHEREAS, owners and occupiers of residences or places of business should be free from uninvited visitors during certain times;

WHEREAS, it is the City's intent that this ordinance regulate the time during which a person may solicit within the city limits, and not prohibit or hamper speech;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 5.12.125 is added to the Hood River Municipal Code:

5.12.125 Limitation on hours of solicitation. No person, whether or not the person is required to be licensed under this chapter, shall go from residence to residence or from place to place within the city for the purpose of peddling, soliciting, poll taking, conducting a survey, or for any other purpose without the invitation of the persons residing or working within such locations, after 8 p.m. or before 8 a.m.

Read for the first time: June 28, 1999.

Read for the second time and passed: July 12, 1999, to become effective thirty (30) days hence.
