ORDINANCE NO. 1788

(An ordinance re-adopting public contracting rules of procedure)

WHEREAS, under HRMC Section 2.32.100, the City has adopted some but not all of the Oregon Administrative Rules pertaining to public contracting;

WHEREAS, House Bill (HB) 2024, which became effective October 23, 1999, states that unless the City adopts its own rules of procedure for public contracting, the model rules adopted by the Attorney General would apply to the local jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Justice has advised local jurisdictions that they should re-adopt their own rules of procedure in order to avoid the default provisions in HB 2024;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this ordinance to take effect immediately so as not to cause the City to violate public contracting procedures, or to cause a break or inconsistencies in the City's public contracting procedures;

WHEREAS, for the reason set forth above, this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the safety, health and welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Hood River ordains as follows:

1. The City readopts the rules of procedure set forth in HRMC Section 2.32.100.


Read for the first time: December 13, 1999.
