

ORDINANCE NO. 1799

(An ordinance amending Hood River Municipal Code Chapter 17.14 regarding the composition of the Landmarks Review Board)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.14 .040 of the Hood River Municipal Code, the City created the City of Hood River Landmarks Review Board to advise the Planning Commission and City Council about the City’s historic landmarks and districts;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.14.050, the Landmarks Review Board is comprised of seven members, four of whom must reside within the City of Hood River and all of whom must reside within Hood River County;

WHEREAS, the City Council has had difficulty filling vacancies for the four positions with the City residential requirement with persons who otherwise meet the professional requirements of Section 17.14.050;

WHEREAS, individuals who reside in the Urban Growth Area have expressed an interest in serving on the Landmarks Board;

WHEREAS, the interests of the City would continue to be represented if the City residential requirement for the four positions was expanded to include the City’s Urban Growth Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 17.14 of the Hood River Municipal Code is amended as follows:

Chapter 17.14 HISTORIC PRESERVATION

17.14.050 COMPOSITION


The Landmarks Board shall be composed of seven members who shall be appointed by the City Council. Four members shall live within the City of Hood River or the Urban Growth Area. All members shall reside within Hood River County. When making appointments . . . shall serve without compensation.

Read for the first time: June 26, 2000

Read for the second time and passed: July 10, 2000, to become effective thirty (30) days hence.
