## ORDINATVCE NO. 2003

An ordinance providing for the manner of numbering buildings in the City of Hood River, Oregon.

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER DOES ORDAIN IS FOLIOWS:
Section 1. That all buildings in the City of Hood Siver,Oregon shall be numbered in the manner hereinafter set out and not otherwise.

Section 2.W That the buildings along all streets running in the gencral easterly and westerly direction shall be numbered both East and $\#$ Fest from Front Street as the base line and for all buildings Tast of Front Street the word East shall be affixed after the number and street. One number shall be allowed for each 25 feet of frontage on the street line and the humbering shall begin on the North side of the street with the number 2 and the even number shall be maintained on the North side of said street throughout; on the south side of the street the numbering shall begin with 1 and the oud numbergshall continue on the south side of the street throughout. Second
 used for the ground floor. Each block shall begin with even hundreds from First Street West and from East First street $\mathrm{Hast}_{\text {a }}$, and units and tens shall be used in numbering the block from Front to First Streets and from Front to East First Street. The numbers in each block shall, when read alternately from side to side, be consecutive for the ground numbers.

Section 3.- That the buildings along all streets running in a general Northerly and Southerly direction shall be numbered both North and South from Columbia Street as the base line and one number shall be allowed for each 25 feet of frontage on the street line。All numbers North of Columbia Street shall be distinguished from those South by affixing the word North after the number and street. The even numbers shall be used in numbering buildings on the fast side of the street beginning with number 2 , both Nortin and South from Columbia stare Street, and the odd numberg be used in numbering the buildings on the West side of the street beginning with number $I$, both North and gouth. The units and tens shall be used in numbering the first block both North and South of Columbia Street and thereafter each block
shall begin with even consecutive hundreds, which method of numbering shall be maintained throughout.

Section 4.- When streets running North and South have not been extended through continuously, numbers shall be given to those lots intersected by the street line allowing one number for each thirty feet of the width of the street, after which the numbering shall proceed as if the street had been extended through, and as provided for for numbering a new block.
