

An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance providing for the passage of Ordinances and Repealing Ordinance Number forty-five"

The City of Wood River does Ordain as follows:

Section 1. Every Ordinance shall be read at two (2) Regular meetings of the Common Council, not less than five (5) days apart, before they can be acted upon for final passage: - Provided that by unanimous consent of all the members of the Common Council an Ordinance may be passed at its first and second readings and final passage at any regular meeting of the Common Council.

Section 2. - Every ordinance shall be passed ~~at its first~~ by a vote of the majority of the Common Council. The vote upon the final passage of an ordinance shall be by yeas and nays and the name and vote of every member voting shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.

Section 3. - Ordinance number forty-five (45) is hereby repealed.
