

ORDINANCE NO

67

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No 63, entitled "An Ordinance granting to the Hood River Electric Light, Power and Water Company the right to lay pipes and mains through the streets, alleys and public grounds of the City of Hood River for the purpose of carrying water into, through and throughout said City, and to supply the inhabitants thereof with water, and for providing means of extinguishing fires.

The CITY OF HOOD RIVER DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No 63, entitled "An Ordinance granting to the Hood River Electric Light, Power and Water Company the right to lay pipes and mains through the streets, alleys and public grounds of the City of Hood River for the purpose of carrying water into, through and throughout said city, and to supply the inhabitants thereof with water, and for providing means of extinguishing fires", passed by the Common Council October 6th 1902, approved by the Mayor October 10th 1902, be and the same is hereby repealed.

By virtue of an order of the Board of Directors of the said Hood River Electric Light, Power and Water Company made and entered of record on the 6th day of December 1902 I hereby, and on behalf of said Company, hereby consent that said Ordinance No 63 be repealed, and respectfully request the Hon. Common Council to pass the above repealing ordinance as soon as possible.
