

An Ordinance to Punish Minors over the age of Sixteen years for obtaining or attempting to obtain Intoxicating Liquors under false pretenses.

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: If any minor over the age of sixteen years shall, within the limits of the City of Hood River, for the purpose of inducing any person to give or sell to such minor any intoxicating liquor, represent to such person that such minor is twenty one years of age, or upwards, such minor, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty five dollars nor more than one hundred and fifty dollars.

Section 2. It is hereby made the duty of the City Marshal and City Attorney, and all police officers of said City of Hood River to see that this ordinance is enforced.
