

ORDINANCE NO. ⁷⁶ ~~BEING AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF IRVING AND FIRST~~
STREETS IN THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER OREGON.

WHEREAS, The Oregon Railroad & Navigation Company has presented its petition and consent for the vacation of those portions of Irving Street and of First Street, in the City of Hood River, hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the said Company is the owner of all the property adjoining or abutting upon said portions of said streets, the City of Hood River does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That all that portion of Irving Street, in the City of Hood River which lies north of the north line of Railroad Street, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That all of that portion of First Street in the City of Hood River which lies north of a line extending north seventy six degrees fifty minutes west from a point in the west line of Block Sixteen, in the City of Hood River, which point is ninety feet north of the South west corner of said block Sixteen be and the same is hereby vacated.
