

ORDINANCE No. 78

An Ordinance to Amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 48, entitled "An Ordinance to Regulate the Laying out and Platting Additions to the City of Hood River", passed by the Common Council of the City of Hood River March 17th, 1902 and approved by the Mayor *March 17* 1902 x

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of Ordinance No. 48, the said Ordinance No. 48 being entitled "An Ordinance to Regulate the laying out and Platting Additions to the City of Hood River, passed by the Common Council March 17th, 1902, and approved by the Mayor *March 17*" 1902 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person or persons hereafter laying out and platting any addition to the City of Hood River, whether the same be within the corporate limits of said city or adjacent thereto, shall cause the same to conform in size of blocks and width of streets to that portion of said city already laid out and platted adjacent to and adjoining such addition; and all additions to said city hereafter laid out as aforesaid shall be so laid out and platted that all streets shall correspond with and be continuations of the streets, roads and highways already laid out and existing in that portion of the said city adjoining such new addition. And all plats of additions to said city hereafter laid out as aforesaid shall be prepared in duplicate and shall be submitted to the common council of said City of Hood River for its approval. When such plat shall have been approved by the said common council it may then be filed and recorded, and the duplicate plat shall be filed with and remain in the custody of the Recorder of said City of Hood River.
