

ORDINANCE NO. 833

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF POLICE AND PRESCRIBING HIS DUTIES.

The City of Hood River does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The police department shall consist of a chief of police and such other officers as the council may appoint.

Section 2. The chief of police shall have direct supervision over the city police department, and it shall be his duty to diligently enforce all ordinances of the city, and he shall perform the duties of the city marshal and deputy health officer.

Section 3. He shall serve and execute and make return on all process issued to him by the city recorder or directed to him by any magistrate of this state. He shall attend all meetings of the council and shall act as sergeant at arms of the council.

Section 4. The chief of police shall have direct supervision of the city jail and shall have the custody of all city prisoners and inmates confined therein and shall be responsible for their safekeeping.

He shall keep a record of the city prisoners in which shall be entered the name, age, sex, color, and occupation of every person confined in the city jail, or to his care, whether upon commitment or not, with the date and duration of imprisonment, together with a list of all articles of value found upon the person of each prisoner.

Section 5. The chief of police shall receive an annual salary which shall be fixed by the council and shall be paid as the salaries of other city officials are paid, said salary shall be in full payment for all services rendered and performed by the said chief of police for the city.
