

ORDINANCE No. 84

An ordinance entitled an ordinance to prohibit the selling or offering for sale in the City of Hood River of transient stocks of goods, wares or merchandise, without first procuring a license so to do.

THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Transient merchants selling, or in any manner offering for sale, any goods, wares or merchandise, within the city of Hood River, Oregon, whether at auction or private sale, shall pay \$75. per week as a license therefor, or the sum of \$15. per day for such license for any shorter period than one week.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation temporarily engaging in the business of selling or offering for sale in said city any goods, wares or merchandise, whether at auction or private sale, shall be deemed a transient merchant within the meaning of this ordinance.

~~Section 3. Any person required by this ordinance to procure a license who shall fail to do so shall, upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not less than \$25. nor more than \$200.~~

Section 3. Any transient merchant who shall sell or offer for sale in said city of Hood River any goods, wares or merchandise, without having first secured a license therefor, shall be punished, upon conviction thereof, by a fine of not less than \$25. nor more than \$200.

Section 4. The recorder of said City of Hood River shall issue licenses to transient merchants upon the payment to him of the license fee as hereinbefore provided.
