

## **Resolution 2023-15**

### **A Resolution Adopting a General Public, Non-Commercial, Septage Dumping Fee to be included in the Consolidated Schedule of Fees, Rates, and Charges for all General Public**

WHEREAS, the City Council establishes the fees, rates, and charges for all city services, permits and applications by resolution, and most recently by the adoption of Resolution 2023-02; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary and proper for the City to review and revise this Schedule annually in preparation for preparation of the City's annual budget; and


WHEREAS, the City currently charges a per gallon fee for all commercial septage hauler dumping;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it to be in the City's best interest to also implement a general public, non-commercial, Septage Dumping Fee;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined ten dollars (\$10) per dump for all non-commercial dumping to be an acceptable and equitable fee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hood River City Council that the General Public, Non-Commercial, Septage Dumping Fee of \$10/dump are hereby adopted and shall be included in the Consolidated Schedule of Fees, Rates, and Charges, starting November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023:
