

RESOLUTION 67-23

WHEREAS in the death of GEORGE E. JOHNSON, affectionately known to all his associates as "Ned", on November 27, 1967, the community of Hood River has lost an active worker, the City of Hood River an able, just and fair dispenser of justice, and its inhabitants a warm friend. At the time of his passing he was and for more than five years had served this City as Municipal Judge and prior to that had served this community as Justice of the Peace for more than six years. The regard with which he was held by the community is a testimonial to the fair and equitable treatment received by all who appeared in his court. He will be remembered as an admired and respected associate and as an affectionate friend. The City Council wishes to make this testimonial of his service to the community, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that this Resolution be an official recognition of the loss to the City of Hood River by the death of GEORGE E. JOHNSON and that the sympathy of the Council be extended to the members of his family.
