## RESOLUTION NO. 69-5-

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Hood River has set the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 1969, at the hour of 7:45 P. M. at the Council Chambers in the City Hall of the City of Hood River, Oregon, the same being the time and place set for the hearing on the report that the building on the property in the City of Hood River, County of Hood River, State of Oregon, described as:

Lot 20, Block 2, Idlewilde Addition to the City of Hood River, Oregon

is a dangerous condition and constitutes a public hazard and the notice thereof was given to the owners of the above described real property, and they did appear and the Council having fully considered the matter,

The Council finds that the building on the premises above described is in a dangerous condition and constitutes a public hazard.

Therefore BE IT RESOLVED that the building on the above described premises is dangerous and constitutes a public hazard and the City Administrator shall give written notice to the owner to remove the building or renovate the building to minimum standards specified by the City Engineer and if the owner fails to secure a satisfactory building permit or remove the same within thirty days thereof then the Administrator shall proceed to have the same removed and charge the cost thereof to the real property upon which such building is situated and in the event that said assessment for cost is made that the same shall be done by ordinance and entered in the Docket of City Liens.
