RESOLUTION NO. 71-13
(Designation of Mayor to Make Application for Federal
and State Sewer Aid Grants)

WHEREAS the Congress of the United States of America passed the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to assist communities in the control of water pollution and there are also certain state grants which are available to assist in the development of an overall sewer system for the lower Hood River Valley on the west side of the stream of Hood River and for the City of Hood River,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Hood River be and he is hereby authorized and designated as the official of the City of Hood River to make application for federal grants under Public Law No. 84-660 and for such state funds as may now or hereafter be made available to the City of Hood River for the construction and development of the secondary sewerage treatment plant serving both lands within the City of Hood River and outside the City of Hood River in the populated area immediately to the south and west of the City of Hood River boundaries.
