

MEMORIAL NO. 71-2

(Requesting State Legislature to provide for an early election on the Motor Vehicle Registration Fee Increase)

WHEREAS the referral of the proposed Motor Vehicle Registration Fee increase has caused a drastic curtailment in the budgets of all counties and cities and particularly in the matters of street maintenance, parks, and police departments for the City of Hood River, and


WHEREAS the referral of decision on the proposed tax until a general election to be held in November, 1972, seriously handicaps the cities and counties and fails to give sufficient time to prepare a sound budget for the 1972-73 year, and

WHEREAS there is an imperative need for an early determination of such proposed tax, therefore,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER:

1. Requests that the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Oregon take immediate action to assure an early vote and in no event later than March 31, 1972, on the matter referred to the electorate of the state by referendum on the 1971 Legislation effecting said proposed Motor Vehicle Registration Fee increase.
2. Directs that a copy of this Memorial be forwarded to the Senate through its President and to the House of Representatives through its Speaker, both of the State of Oregon, and that copies thereof be forwarded to Senator Kenneth A. Jernstedt, Representative Paul E. Walden, to the League of Oregon Cities and to the press and to the radio.
