

RESOLUTION NO. 72-2

(To provide that the City of Hood River accept appointment as a responsible political subdivision and the Hood River Fire Department as the responsible agency of the Emergency Medical Communication Network)

WHEREAS the Congress of the United States of America has provided matching funds to assist areas within the State of Oregon to establish an Emergency Medical Communication Network and with particular reference to the operation of the continuation of the existing District No. 9 of the State of Oregon comprising the counties of Hood River, Wasco and Sherman, all in the State of Oregon, and it is necessary to continue to have a physical subdivision act as a responsible agent, to have a coordinator for the project, and a project director, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Hood River join for each of the fiscal years from July 1, 1972, through June 30, 1975, with other cooperating municipalities and state subdivisions of the proposed Emergency Medical Communication Network for District No. 9 of the State of Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Hood River accept the responsibility of acting as the political subdivision for District No. 9 of the State of Oregon for the Emergency Medical Communication Network and hereby designates the Hood River Fire Department as the responsible agency thereof with Jan Kurahara to act as coordinator of the project and Fire Chief Jim Meyer to act as project director.
