RESOLUTION NO. 72-5

(Providing for the submission of an initiative petition for dog control ordinance to the electorate at the primary election to be held May 23, 1972)

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the City Recorder an initiative petition for a proposed dog control ordinance and that it is proper that the same be submitted to the voters at an early date, and the Council determines that the same should be submitted to the voters, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hood River that the proposed dog control ordinance be placed on the non-partisan ballot of Hood River County for the seven precincts within the City of Hood River for the action of the electorate at the primary election to be held Tuesday, May 23, 1972.
